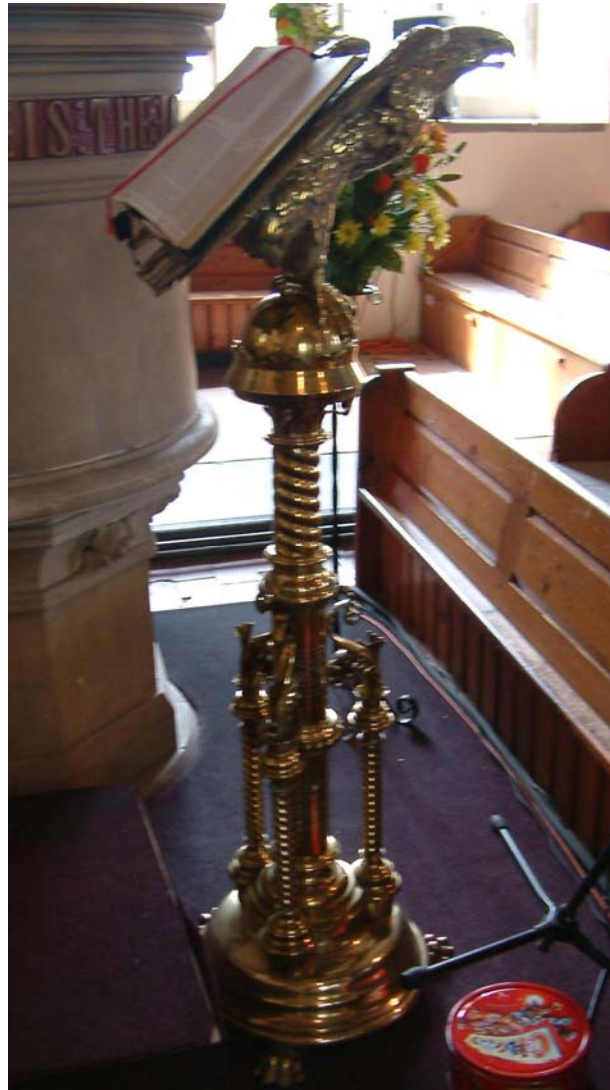


THE KIDSON LECTERN

The Rev Kidson commissioned a novel and appropriate memorial for his lost son, which was both a memorial and practical. It was a lectern in the shape of an eagle. Every reading the Rev gave could be done using his own memorial to his son. If you were to go into Holy Trinity today the Lectern is still there and still used nearly 100 years later.
