

## RODMERSHAM.

RODMERSHAM WAR MEMORIAL. — There has been on view at the monumental works of Messrs. Thomas Fowle and Son, Chatham, a beautifully-executed Scroll of Honour, which is to be erected and dedicated in Rodmersham Parish Church. It is four feet high, is executed in solid bronze, and bears the Rampant Horse of Kent at the top, with the dates 1914, 1919, on either side, with the motto, "Finis Coronato pus." In a panel on the right hand side is the raised figure of a soldier, carrying a full kit, and on the opposite side that of a sailor with a rifle on his shoulder. At the foot of the shield are the figures of St. George and the Dragon. The names of the fallen heroes from the parish are in raised gilded letters. The inscription is as follows:—
